

In 2005 he started his wine blog "Aristide - blogging around the wine world". That blog was among the very first at that time in Italy to animate the rising panorama of wine world on Internet, well before the advent of social media.

With Elisabetta Tosi - Italian wine journalist - he created the brand "Fermenti Digitali" ("Digital Yeasts"), where he acts as a marketing consultant helping wine producers to promote their brands online, leveraging digital innovations and direct communication with consumers and wine professionals.

In 2008, they both participated to the European Wine Blogger Conference foundation in Logroño, Spain, later denominated **Digital Wine Communication Conference**.
